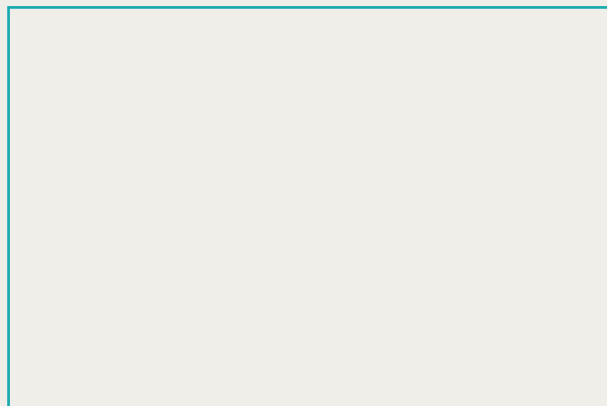

## RIVERSIDE/ROSEVEARS REGION

### 1 Tamar Valley Truffles *349 Ecclestone Road, Riverside*

#### TRUFFLE FARM

HT T S

Magnificent farm and leading producer of black perigord truffles. Walk alongside stately oak trees where the truffles flourish and hear about the growth habits of this mysterious culinary delight. Finish the tour with samples of award winning truffled products.

### 2 Brady's Lookout Cider *9 Craythorne Rd, Rosevears*

#### APPLE ORCHARD & CIDER MAKERS

HT D P S T

A picturesque orchard high on the sloping Tamar riverbanks, planted with over eighty-five heritage apple varieties and nurtured using organic principles. The apples are used to produce Methode Traditionelle sparkling ciders, with cider mill and cellar door on site.

### 3 Village Olive Grove *26 Skyline Ave, Grindelwald*

#### OLIVES & OLIVE OIL

ST T S

A picturesque grove consistently producing top quality, award winning oil. See the trees in flower and bud, and sample the oil, olives and dukkah. Walk around the grove for stunning views of the Tamar and a demonstration of olive harvesting.

## EXETER REGION

### 4 Honey Tasmania *124 Main Rd, Exeter*

#### HONEY & BEES

HT D P S T

The Beehive shop and garden brings you the world of bees and honey, with beehives you can see right into. Sample honey treats, enjoy a ramble in the garden and learn all about bees and how to save them.

### 5 Lentara Grove *2670 West Tamar Hwy, Exeter*

#### OLIVES & POMEGRANATES

HT D S T

One of Tasmania's oldest olive groves with award-winning oils, and pressing and processing on-site. Now the state's first commercial scale pomegranate farm too. Sample the range of oil, dukkah, tapenade, olives and sumptuous skincare too.

### 6 Marions Vineyard *335 Deviot Rd, Deviot*

#### VINEYARD & BIODYNAMICS

HT L P S T

One of the valley's oldest established vineyard and wineries with magnificent views over the Tamar. Second generation winemakers integrating organic and biodynamic principles into the vineyard, olive grove and market gardens. Stay for a platter, sample the wine and produce.

### 7 Tascargot *150 Hjorts Rd, Loira*

#### SNAIL FARM & VINEYARD

HT D P S T

The one and only snail farm in the Tamar, on a vineyard and combining slow food and slow wine. Learn about the escargot, go behind the scenes in the winery, stay for a nibble and a glass of wine.

## GLENGARRY REGION

### 8 Bridgenorth Berries *421 Long Plains Rd, Bridgenorth*

#### BERRIES

ST S

A boutique berry orchard with berry canes of different varieties in flower. Tour the orchard, visit the chickens and sheep, learn about farming berries and stop at the 'shed door' for frozen boysenberries and jams.

### 9 Glengarry Dairy *547 South Winkleigh Rd, Glengarry*

#### DAIRY FARM

ST P T

Family run farm on 400 acres of lush pasture. Learn about the life of a dairy cow and what it takes to produce milk, with herd health a priority. Visit the calves and sample the products Tasmanian milk goes into. Last tour at 2pm.

### 10 Grey Sands Vineyard *6 Kerrisons Rd, Glengarry*

#### VINEYARD & GARDENS

ST D P S T

Grey Sands Wines are cellared prior to release and are some of the most exceptional cool climate wines in the region. Learn more from Rita and Bob in the tour. The amazing "collectors" garden is open all day to enjoy.

## ROWELLA REGION

### 11 Tamar Valley Organics *11 Waterton Hall Rd, Rowella*

#### WALNUTS

HT S T

In this mature walnut orchard with stunning views over the riverside Rowella area, trees are tended by hand using organic principles. See the nutlets growing, learn about harvesting, washing and drying and sample the walnuts – soft, sweet and delicious.

### 12 Waterton Hall Vineyard *61 Waterton Hall Rd, Rowella*

#### HISTORIC ESTATE AND VINEYARD

HT D P S T

Last convict built property in Tasmania, a spectacular estate with riverfront location and now under vine. Take a 'history, walking and talking' tour to hear the stories of the historic barn, hall and gardens, boathouse and schoolhouse, with wine and savoury nibbles in hand.

### 13 Wilmore's Bluff *37 Blackwood Hills Rd, Rowella*

#### SHEEP & CATTLE

HT P S

A large farm with over one thousand Cormo Sheep and one hundred head of cattle on a magnificent riverside property. Meet local spinners and knitters, tour the shearing shed and livestock yards and visit petting animals. Lamb fleeces for spinning available.
